Subcommittee 1

O'Sullivan reported possibly using suggestions from other committee's research to resolve this issue. The issue is still being worked.

#### Subcommittee 2

Project 77881 Account Transcripts

Simpson reported working with the Office of Online Services (OLS) spoke of previous work being done regarding how the taxpayer discerns this form and what can be improved. We looked from practitioner's perspective. Stacy Cloyd from Special Projects corresponded with Simpson regarding working a similar project 63737 Data on Wage and Income Transcripts. Simpson indicated they are looking for full Employee Identification Numbers (EINs).

The IRS' response was because it is available upon request, this has already been implemented. Taxpayers are looking to have this information unmasked without having to take extra steps to ask for it. Simpson spoke about this to minimize the burden on taxpayers since this is not social security numbers. Simpson inquired about why they can't automatically be unmasked, which is a goal of the project.

## New Issue Screening Report

O'Sullivan reported screening May 8, 2025:

There were a number of issues reviewed with many of them dropped because they were individual or tax issues outside the scope of TAP. Some of them were associated with existing issues, which we were able to close them. Some were unclear or inconclusive and one issue required further research. Simpson will



write about an issue related to the VITA review project. Simpson will write about an issue going to the Toll-Free phone Line committee regarding getting a person on the phone for assistance.

#### **Outreach**

Quan Doan provided an update on the activities of the Outreach Committee

Doan under stood limitations in outreach activities due to budget constraints and spoke about several members doing outreach via personal social media accounts. Doan reminded members to update their activity reports with all TAP activities.
